

## **Conflict Minerals Statement**

Isocom Components 2004 Ltd. is committed to maintaining a socially and environmentally responsible supply chain. We recognise the importance of ethical sourcing and the impact that conflict minerals can have on communities in affected regions.

In line with this commitment, we actively work to prevent the use of illegal or unethical metal sourcing from conflict-affected areas in our products. The metals in question, referred to as 3TG, include:

- Tantalum (Ta)
- Tungsten (W)
- Tin (Sn)
- Gold (Au)

To ensure compliance with this commitment, we have implemented robust supplier engagement practices. Based on information provided by our suppliers, we do not knowingly use metals derived from conflict-affected areas in any of our products. We maintain thorough documentation to support this status and conduct regular reviews of our supply chain practices.

We actively support our customers' efforts to achieve a socially and environmentally responsible supply chain. Isocom Components 2004 Ltd. aligns with the initiatives of the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA) and the Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSI), promoting ethical sourcing practices and continuous improvement in our operations.
